Setting up Your Own Scenarios

Some of the custom scenery in this route is contained in the scenarios, not the route scenery tiles. This includes many of the GN specific lineside signs, all the newly placed historic depots, and the station signs.

You can easily use those in your scenarios by copying the "scenery" folder from any of the route's original scenarios into your own scenario. Please see below for a step-by-step guide on how to do that:

- 1) Go to the "Build" menu in Train Simulator.
- 2) Open the "Scenario" tab in the Build menu.
- 3) Scroll through the list until you find the "Montana Hi-Line (1950s)" route and click on it.
- 4) Click on the entry for the "Scenery Template" free roam scenario.
- 5) Click on the "**Open"** button on the bottom right corner of the screen. This will open an Explorer window of this scenario's folder on your HD.
- 6) [not pictured] In that folder, select and **copy the subfolder** named "Scenery". It should be the only subfolder in that window.
- 7) [not pictured] Repeat steps 1 through 5 for your own scenario, and **paste the Scenery folder** from step (6) into your own scenario's folder.
